TELLURIDE FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT RESOLUTION NO. 2023-01 RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF REAL PROPERTY

WHEREAS, the Telluride Fire Protection District (the "District") is a Colorado Special District that provides firefighting and fire suppression services, emergency medical assistance and search and rescue services for the Towns Telluride, Mountain Village, Ophir and Sawpit, as well as parts of unincorporated San Miguel County; and

WHEREAS, it is a priority for the District to maintain adequate staffing levels; and

WHEREAS, in order to do so, the District needs to assist with providing housing and housing assistance for its employees; and

WHEREAS, on April 20, 2023, the District entered into a Contract to Buy and Sell Real Estate as Buyer with KAREN B. PENTECOST AND DONALD H. PENTECOST, COTRUSTEES OF THE KAREN B. PENTECOST LIVING TRUST DATED THE 11TH DAY OF NOVEMBER 2020, AS AMENDED, as Seller (the "Contract") for the purchase of 323 Adams Ranch Road, Unit 4A, Mountain Village, CO 81434 (the "Property"); and

WHEREAS, at its regular monthly Board Meeting in May, the Board of Directors for the District ratified the Contract; and

WHEREAS, the District is set to close on the purchase of the Property on Tuesday, May 30, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the Board wishes to authorize District Chief Bennet on behalf of the District to complete the purchase of the Property.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS FOR THE TELLURIDE FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT, on this 16th day of May 2023:

- 1. The entity purchasing the Property, 323 Adams Ranch Road, Unit 4A, Mountain Village, CO 81435 is the Telluride Fire Protection District.
- 2. The entity is a Title 32 Fire Protection District, duly authorized and in good standing with the laws of the State of Colorado.
- 3. The address for the entity is 131 W. Columbia Ave., PO Box 1645, Telluride, CO 81435.
- 4. District Chief John Bennet is authorized to execute all closing documents on behalf of the entity, including a Statement of Authority pursuant to C.R.S. 38-30-172.

5. District Chief Bennett is authorized to undertake all necessary and appropriate actions to complete the closing of the Contract and purchase the Property.
